

## Homework: Simple Money Word Problems

Tom had \$140. He bought a bicycle for \$55, a scooter for \$45, and candy for \$6. How much money did he have left?

Tom had \$140

He bought a bicycle = \$55

a scooter = \$45

candy = \$6

$$= 55 + 45 + 6 = 106$$

$$= 140 - 106 = 34$$

**Answer: 34**

4	Bob had 5 dimes and 12 nickels. He earned 2 quarters, 2 dimes, and 4 pennies. How much money does he have now?
5	A book costs \$75. Bob only has \$59. How much more money does he need to buy the book?
6	The class earned \$3 a day for one week for their school trip. How much money did they have by the end of the week?
7	Timmy had \$116. He bought a big Frisbee for \$15, a pair of roller blades for \$45, and fish for \$9. How much money did he have left?
8	A notebook cost \$16. The customer gave the lady \$8. How much change did the customer get back?
9	A family spent \$12 on cotton candy, \$9 on a balloon, and \$85 on tickets for the Ferris wheel. How much did the family spend?
10	In Dick's piggy bank, he found 3 dollars, 5 quarters, 10 dimes, and 4 nickels. How much money was in the piggy bank altogether?
11	Lisa has 5 quarters. Her mother gives her 5 nickels and 6 dimes. How much money does she have now?
12	Bobby had \$62. She bought an MP3 music player for \$53. How much money does she have left?
