4. The two tallest mountains in the world are in China, Mt. Everest at 8850 meters and K2 at 8611 meters. If you stacked them on top of each other how tall would they be?
5. Monika wants to buy a pear, a candy bar, and a carton of milk. The pear costs \$0.65. The milk costs \$1.25. The candy bar costs \$0.99. Monika has \$3.00. How much money will Monika have left over if she buys all three items?
